

# **BOMB THREAT MANAGEMENT PLANNING**



### TRAINING COURSE OVERVIEW

Bomb Threat Management (BTM) Planning (MGT-451) provides foundational knowledge on the DHS risk management process, bomb threat management procedures, and gives participants the opportunity to apply this knowledge in developing and executing a BTM plan.
