

Protective Measures Awareness (AWR-340)

The **Protective Measures Awareness** course introduces how to identify and mitigate facility security gaps. This course provides foundational knowledge about risk management and the three rings of security: physical, procedural/technical, and intelligence protective measures.

Course Format and Audience

This 60-minute Virtual Instructor-led Training (VILT)* is delivered by a live instructor to cover the following topics:

- Overview of risks
- DHS risk management process
- Physical, procedural and intelligence protective measures

This course is designed for small groups of up to 50 participants and is intended for audiences such as:

- Critical infrastructure owners and operators
- Public safety officers
- Emergency managers
- Security officers
- Law enforcement officials
- Private sector security professionals
