



Bombing Prevention Awareness (AWR-348)

CISA OFFICE FOR BOMBING PREVENTION

The **Bombing Prevention Awareness** course provides an overview of IEDs and explosive effects, homemade explosives, an introduction to the terrorist attack cycle, and response to suspicious behaviors and items. This basic awareness is used to enhance bombing prevention measures.



Course Format and Audience

This is a one-day, in-person instructor-led training covering the following topics:

- IED construction and classification
- IED explosive effects and mitigation
- HME and precursor awareness
- Introduction to the terrorist attack cycle
- Response to suspicious behaviors and items

This course is designed for groups of up to 250 participants and is intended for audiences such as:

- Critical infrastructure owners and operators
- Public safety officers
- Emergency managers
- Security officers
- Law enforcement officers
- Private sector security professionals
