

## FIREWORKS THREAT AWARENESS

These products are commonly used as bomb-making materials. Industry members should familiarize themselves with these behaviors that may indicate intent for unlawful use and report suspicious activity.

## POTENTIALLY SUSPICIOUS CUSTOMER ACTIVITY:

- Q Insisting on paying cash or using another person's credit card
- Q Unwilling or reluctant to produce a valid I.D.
- Acting nervous, being evasive, or hiding from security cameras
- Q Inquiring about odd bulk, or large purchases
- Making unusual or bulk purchases in off-peak periods
- Making statements regarding illegal or misuse of explosives
- Q Showing abnormal interest in the explosive power of the product
- Q Expressing interest in removing explosive powder from the product
- Q Buying similar products from multiple vendors/suppliers

## WHAT CAN YOU DO? FOLLOW THESE SIMPLE STEPS:

- Ask questions, listen to their responses, and observe their behavior
- Know your customers and report suspicious activity
- Ask for customer I.D. and maintain a log of unusual purchases
- Keep track of inventory and report missing or stolen products
- Notify your local FBI office of any suspicious activities









## KNOW YOUR CUSTOMERS. BE AWARE. YOUR EFFORT MAKES A DIFFERENCE.

Businesses can become unwitting participants in illicit or terrorist activities. Be aware of unusual or suspicious purchases or misuse of your products and services.
