



BOMB THREAT ASSESSMENT FOR DECISION MAKERS



TRAINING COURSE OVERVIEW

Bomb Threat Assessment for Decision Makers (AWR-945) introduces the participant to types of threats, threat assessment process, and implementing a Bomb Threat Management (BTM) plan. It provides activities for participants to apply specific portions of the risk management process and their newly acquired knowledge about BTM procedures to develop a risk assessment of a bomb threat.

COURSE INFORMATION

This one-hour instructor-led training covers the following topics:

- Procedures for evaluating a threat
- Low, moderate, and high-risk bomb threats
- Considerations related to searching, evacuating, and reoccupying following a bomb threat

This course is designed for groups of up to 50 participants and is intended for audiences such as:

- Critical infrastructure owners and operators
- Emergency managers
- Private sector security professionals
- Security officers

- Computer or mobile device
- Internet connection
