**Detail Location and Description:** Opportunity to serve as a Senior Counsel for the Office of the Chief Counsel (OCC), Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA), Department of Homeland Security (DHS).

**Summary:** This position, located in the DHS Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA) Office of the Chief Counsel (OCC), will report to the Chief Counsel and Principal Deputy Chief Counsel. This Senior Counsel will assist and coordinate on legal matters and issues that apply to CISA and DHS; many of these matters are cross-cutting and do not fall exclusively within the portfolios of OCC's current legal divisions. The Senior Counsel will also serve as a point of contact to counterparts in other U.S. Government offices responsible for mission space pertaining, but not limited, to cybersecurity, infrastructure security, and intelligence.

During the detail period and for a period of one year from the end of the detail, CISA OCC will not hire any detailed attorney selected under this announcement.
