



SECURITY AND RESILIENCE FOR BOMBING INCIDENTS



TRAINING COURSE OVERVIEW

Security and Resilience for Bombing Incidents (MGT-916) assists in planning and implementing counter-improvised explosive device (C-IED) activities within overall public safety and emergency management approaches for organizations and communities. It covers common C-IED specific security and resiliency goals to build bombing prevention capabilities at the organizational/jurisdictional level.

COURSE INFORMATION

This 4.5-hour instructor-led training discusses the following topics:

- Considerations needed when analyzing current bombing prevention capabilities
- Sustainment actions or corrective actions for capability gaps
- C-IED preparedness resources available

This course is designed for groups of up to 25 participants and is intended for experienced emergency management personnel.
