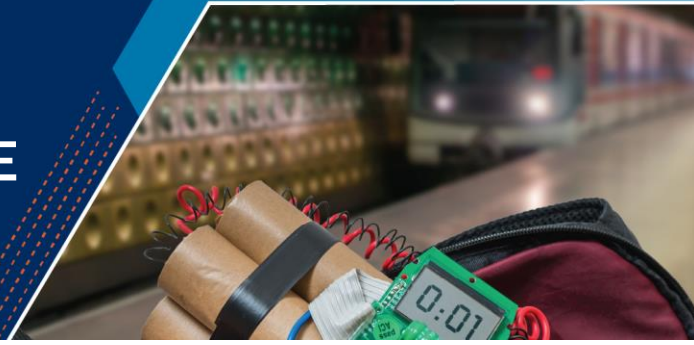




VEHICLE-BORNE IMPROVISED EXPLOSIVE DEVICE DETECTION



TRAINING COURSE OVERVIEW

Vehicle-Borne Improvised Explosive Device (VBIED) Detection (PER-312) provides participants with the knowledge and skills to successfully and safely inspect for, identify, and/or respond to vehicle-borne explosive threats.

COURSE INFORMATION

This one-day instructor-led training covers the following topics:

- Vehicle-borne explosive threat overview
- Identifying vehicle-borne explosive hazards
- Assessment of vehicles and occupant behavior
- Vehicle inspection demonstration and activity

This course is designed for groups of up to 24 participants and is intended for audiences such as:

- Critical infrastructure owners and operators
- Public safety officers
- Emergency managers
- Private sector security professionals
- Security officers
- Law enforcement officers
