



# Introduction to the Terrorist Attack Cycle (AWR-334)

CISA OFFICE FOR BOMBING PREVENTION

The Introduction to the Terrorist Attack Cycle course introduces common steps involved in planning and executing terrorist attacks. This course provides participants with the understanding of how to prevent, protect against, respond to, and mitigate attacks that use Improvised Explosive Devices (IED).



#### **Course Format and Audience**

This 90-minute Virtual Instructor-led Training (VILT)\* is delivered by a live instructor to cover the following topics:

- What is a terrorist and identifying terrorism
- Understanding the terrorist attack cycle
- Countering terrorist attacks before they happen

\* May be delivered in-person in some circumstances

This course is designed for small groups of up to 50 participants and is intended for audiences such as:

- Critical infrastructure owners and operators
- Public safety officers
- Emergency managers
- Security officers
- Law enforcement officials
- Private sector security professionals
