For this last Commemorative Series message, we would like to thank our members' continuous efforts to collaboratively establish policies, monitor compliance, and enhance the security and protection of federal facilities by highlighting our technical assistance and capacity building.

Since the inception — six months after the Oklahoma City bombing — the ISC has worked to build capacity with federal facility security stakeholders, better educating our stakeholders on ISC Standards and Policies. To date, the ISC has completed over 40,000 trainings across the country including ISC members, non-members from across the federal government, state and local officials, as well as private sector participants. Last year the ISC's Risk Management Process & Facility Security Committee (RMP & FSC) Training was IACET accredited, the only ISC training to achieve this distinction. In June 2020, the ISC adapted swiftly, in this pandemic environment, and began offering RMP & FSC as Virtual Instructor-led Training (RMP & FSC — VILT), which enables the ISC to conduct outreach to the farthest corners of our footprint and deliver training to individuals and FSCs that we normally would not be able to reach.
