Independent Study Training (IST) courses are self-paced, web-based courses designed for a broad audience to provide general awareness-level counter-improvised explosive device (C-IED) information to public and private sector partners to enhance awareness of and response to IED threats. These courses are accredited by the International Association for Continuing Education and Training (IACET) and participants receive certificates with contact hours. All courses are provided free of charge.



Independent Study Training Courses



AWR-341: IED Awareness and Safety Procedures

Provides foundational knowledge concerning IEDs and proper safety precautions as well as procedures for reacting and responding to unattended and suspicious items.



AWR-349: Homemade Explosives and Precursor Chemicals Awareness

Provides foundational knowledge about homemade explosives (HME), the precursor chemicals that are used to manufacture HME, and actions to take when encountered.

AWR-903: Bomb Threat Preparedness and Response

AWR-921: Bomb-Making Materials Awareness Employee Training
