What is Interoperability?

Interoperability is the ability of emergency responders to communicate among jurisdictions, disciplines, and levels of government, using a variety of frequency bands, as needed and as authorized.







What is SAFECOM?

- SAFECOM works to improve multijurisdictional and intergovernmental communications interoperability
- SAFECOM coordinates with existing Federal communications programs, elected and appointed officials, and key emergency response stakeholders
- SAFECOM aims to improve processes and policy of existing communications systems and future networks







Interoperability Continuum






