<u>Document Summary</u>: In this Federal Register notice, the Department of Homeland Security announced the implementation of the Personnel Surety Program (PSP), which enables regulated chemical facilities to ensure that individuals seeking unescorted access to restricted areas are screened for terrorist ties. This notice lays out the steps for facilities to take to enroll in the program and explains what information is required to participate.
