



Report Violations of the Chemical Facility Anti- Terrorism Standards (CFATS)

Violations can include:

- > **Failure to report chemicals of interest (COI)**
- > **Knowing submission of false information**
- > **Failure to implement security plan**
- > **Failure to maintain records**

- > Facilities **must** report possession of certain amounts of chemicals of interest (COI) listed in Appendix A of the CFATS regulation.
- > High-risk chemical facilities **must** develop and implement a security plan that addresses security risks.
