## CHEMICAL FACILITY ANTI-TERRORISM STANDARDS

### PREVENT TERRORISTS FROM USING YOUR CHEMICALS

DHS requires facilities to report if they have certain amounts of **322 chemicals**

**All types** of facilities must report, including plants, storage, shippers, users

DHS assesses **security risk** based on factors like chemical type, facility location, facility vulnerability, and potential lives lost

If DHS finds a facility presents a high level of security risk, it must create and implement a **security plan**
